The State Attorney's Office has conducted an independent review of the officer involved incident on March 8, 2021. After full consideration by our Officer Involved Critical Incident team, we have concluded that Officer was justified under applicable Florida law.

Officer Art.1 s.16(b)(5) conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle matching the description of a robbery suspect. The driver, Luis Ceballos Rodriguez, had committed a series of armed robberies and attempted to shoot Office Art.1 s.16(b)(5) during the traffic stop. Art.1 s.16(b)(5) eturned fire in self-defense. Ceballos Rodriguez is currently being prosecuted for the attempted murder of Officer Art.1 s.16(b)(5).
