Dear Sgt. Musser:

The State Attorney's Office has conducted an independent review of the officer involved incident on March 8, 2021. After full consideration by our Officer Involved Critical Incident team, we have concluded that Officer **Art.1 s.16(b)(5)** use of deadly force was justified under applicable Florida law.

Officer **Art.1 s.16(b)(5)** conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle matching the description of a robbery suspect. The driver, Luis Ceballos Rodriguez, had committed a series of armed robberies and attempted to shoot Officer **Art.1 s.16(b)(5)** during the traffic stop. **Art.1 s.16(b)(5)** returned fire in self-defense. Ceballos Rodriguez is currently being prosecuted for the attempted murder of Officer **Art.1 s.16(b)(5)**.
